Mark's Mission Incorporated serves NICU and PICU families by promoting family bonding by helping families overcome financial burdens and social barriers in Northeast Florida. The Food and Financial Assistance Programs provides families with gift certificates to local grocery stores and gas stations to offset any additional costs or loss of income associated with a NICU or PICU stay.

Since January of 2023, Mark's Mission has proudly donated \$1,000 in Food and Fuel Assistance to NICU and PICU families at UF Health Jacksonville and Wolfson Children's Hospital. With our nation still recovering from the COVID-19 pandemic, an increase in unemployment rates, and more preterm births requiring more intense care, we can expect to see this need continue to grow. We are honored to be able to continue to serve our community and further our impact in partnership with the Community Foundation for Northeast Florida.
